The neighborhood will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 to 9p.m. For those who cannot walk and must tour the neighborhood by car, the streets will reopen after 9 p.m. for regular operation.

A portable restroom will be available at the City of Santa Fe Parking Lot located at 761 Canyon Rd.

Santa Fe Trails Will Provide Free Bus Service for the Canyon Road Farolito Walk. Passengers can pick up the free bus service from Santa Fe Place Mall and the South Capitol Rail Runner Station and be transported to Canyon Road at Paseo de Peralta for the Canyon Road Farolito Walk. Hours of free service are from 5:00 p.m. to 9:45 p.m. on Christmas Eve, December 24, 2014. Buses marked "special"

*will pick-up and drop-off continuously during this period. All
Transit Routes are Free of Charge after 5:00 p.m.*
